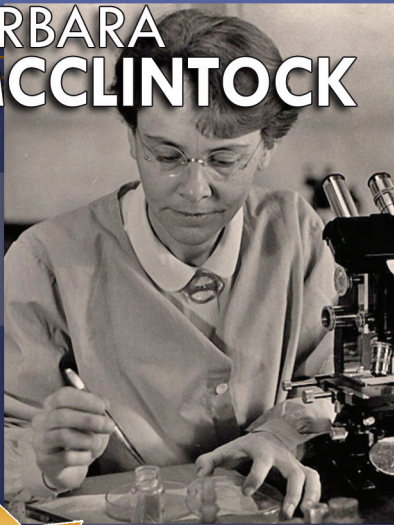


BARBARA MCCLINTOCK
